Spelling

- learning to spell words with suffixes such as ment, -ful, -less,
 -ly.
- Spelling a range of common words such as beautiful, everybody, move, people, money.
- Applying and using phonic knowledge in reading and spelling.

<u>Grammar</u>

- Understanding of terms noun, verb, adjective, pronoun, noun phrase, present and past tenses.
- Recognise and name different sentence types. (Commands, questions, statements, exclamations).
- Name and use punctuation full stops, question mark, exclamation mark, comma, apostrophe for a contraction and possessive apostrophe.

Maths



The principal focus of mathematics teaching in key stage 1 is to ensure that pupils develop confidence and mental fluency with whole numbers, counting and place value. This should involve working with numerals, words and the four operations.

- count in steps of 2, 3, and 5 from 0, and in tens from any number, forward and backward
- read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and in words
- recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers
- solve problems involving multiplication and division, using materials, arrays, repeated addition, mental methods, and multiplication and division facts, including problems in contexts.
- recognise, find, name and write fractions $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity.
- write simple fractions for example, $\frac{1}{2}$ of 6 = 3 and recognise the equivalence of $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$..
- choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length/height in any direction (m/cm); mass (kg/g);
 temperature (°C); capacity (litres/ml) to the nearest appropriate unit, using rulers, scales, thermometers and measuring vessels.
- solve simple problems in a practical context involving addition and subtraction of money of the same unit, including giving change
- tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times
- know the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day.


Monster and Frog at Sea
