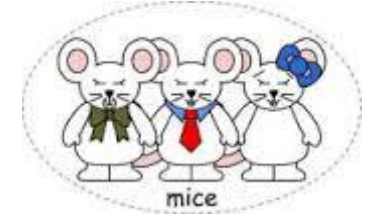




Year R Autumn Topic
