Maths

For our measures work we will be learning about height and using the correct maths language such as tallest, shortest, shorter or taller than to compare objects. For our number work we will be counting forwards and backward to at least 30. We will also be ordering numbers and thinking about how many tens we need when we are making a 2 digit number using numicon.
