

School Behaviour Policy

Over the course of the year we have been working on updating our school Behaviour Policy. We have high expectations of behaviour and the children respond well to those. The Behaviour Policy sets out what we believe in, as a school and how we manage behaviour. The policy is linked to our school vision and is based on three of our six key values, being respectful, being a team and being happy. The draft policy is now up on the school website in the policies section. If you would like to have a look and make a comment we would love to hear from you. The main points of the Behaviour Policy are around how children get awarded green Dojo points. Children can be awarded points for:

- Staying focused
- Asking or answering questions
- Persevering on a task
- Evaluating something they or someone else has done
- Collaborating in a group
- Working well independently
- Using their imagination
- Being a good communicator

Each one of these goes towards a weekly individual and whole class total.

For negative behaviour a red dojo point may be given. This takes a point away from a child's individual total. Negative points may be given for being unkind, not being respectful or not listening. The focus of the school is on positivity and showing good learning behaviours so many more green, positive dojo points are given out than the red negative ones.
